ATTENDANCE INFORMATION FOR PARENTS - HELP YOUR NEW ATTENDANCE OFFICER HELP YOU.

Any pupil absence from school needs to be reported to your Tasker Milward School Attendance Officer, Mrs Hanson-Smith, as soon as possible. This and your regular updates can help us help you and your child.

Details of pupils' essential medical and dental appointments, within the school day, also need to be passed to the Attendance Officer. Absence for appointments must be authorised by your child's Head of Year in advance, in their School Planner if possible, prior to you booking them out at Reception on the day.

Family holidays during term time are discouraged, as this will also have a negative effect your child's education. However, applications to the Headteacher will be considered on their own merits.

Pastoral support in school is always available and your Attendance Officer can arrange contact with staff to support you. For example, providing your child with study material at home.

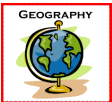
