**Daearreg—Natural Resources Field Work Y12**  
Geologists have just returned from a 2-day intensive field study. We were shown around Cross Hands rock cutting restoration business, and visited Tower Hill Colliery, where the miners are in the process of refilling the opencast operation. Then to Ogmore, to establish the relationship between the Carboniferous limestone and the Triassic flash floods. Next, to Big Pitt,



where we travelled underground to the coal face. Finally a visit to Blaenafon Iron works where the "coal house" series was filmed. Our field work is supported by The PESST Trust, the inspiration of Dr. Andrew Armour to whom we extend our thanks for their support.
