

CYNGOR SIR PENFRO, Neuadd y Sir, Hwlfordd, Sir Benfro, SA61 1TP (y cyfeirir ato o hyn ymlaen fel "Cyngor Sir Penfro").

Rhybuddir yn unol ag adrannau 41 a 43 Deddf Safonau a Threfniadaeth Ysgolion Cymru (2013) a'r Cod Trefniadaeth Ysgolion (Gorffennaf 2013) bod Cyngor Sir Penfro, ar ôl ymgynghori â'r personau angenrheidiol, yn bwriadu gweithredu:

1. O 31 Awst 2018 ymlaen, i ddirwyn i ben yr ysgolion canlynol sydd ar hyn o bryd yn cael eu cynnal gan Gyngor Sir Penfro:
 - Ysgol Syr Thomas Picton, Queensway, Hwlfordd, SA61 2NX.
 - Ysgol G Rh Tasker Milward, Rhodfa Portfield, Hwlfordd, SA61 1EQ.

Nid oes cymeriad crefyddol gan y ddwy ysgol.

2. O 1 Medi 2018, i sefydlu ysgol wirfoddol rheoledig 11-19 newydd (a elwir o hyn ymlaen "Ysgol Uwchradd Hwlfordd newydd") ar gyfer bechgyn a merched ar safleoedd yr ysgolion a enwir uchod. Bydd yr ysgol yn cael ei chynnal gan Gyngor Sir Penfro a'r categori iaith fydd Cyfrwng Saesneg (CS); ni fydd gan yr ysgol gymeriad grefyddol.

Fel y cynigydd, ymgymerodd Cyngor Sir Penfro â chyfnod o ymgynghori cyn penderfynu cyhoeddi'r cynnig hwn. Mae Adroddiad Ymgynghori sy'n cynnwys crynodeb o'r materion a godwyd gan y rhai yr ymgynghorwyd â hwy, ymatebion y cynigydd a barn Estyn wedi ei ystyried gan y Cyngor Sir ac mae ar gael ar wefan y Cyngor (www.pembrokeshire.gov.uk).

Yr Awdurdod Derbyn fydd Cyngor Sir Penfro. Ni fwriedir i'r trefniadau derbyn i'r ysgol newydd ddarparu ar gyfer dewis disgyblion ar sail tueddfryd neu ar sail gallu (bandio disgyblion). Y Rhif Derbyn ar gyfer pob grŵp blwyddyn perthnasol yr ysgol newydd yn ystod y flwyddyn ysgol gyntaf pan fydd y cynigion yn cael eu gweithredu fydd 315. Bydd lle i 1863 o ddisgyblion yn yr ysgol newydd.

Yn unol a bod rhieni yn cael mynegi eu dewis, bwriedir:

- i. Y bydd disgyblion sydd yn mynychu Ysgol Sir Thomas Picton a Ysgol Wirfoddol Tasker Milward ar y dyddiad gweithredu yn cael lle yn Ysgol Uwchradd Hwlfordd newydd.
- ii. Ar wahân i'r disgyblion sydd yn byw yn nhalgylchoedd Ysgol GG Johnston a Ysgol GG Neyland a fyddai wedi disgwyl mynychu Ysgol Sir Thomas Picton neu Ysgol Wirfoddol Tasker Milward oni bai am y cynnig hwn, y bydd disgyblion yn cael eu haddysgu yn yr Ysgol Uwchradd Hwlfordd newydd.
- iii. Y bydd disgyblion sydd yn byw yn nhalgylchoedd Ysgol GG Johnston a Ysgol GG Neyland yn mynychu Ysgol Aberdaugleddau.

PEMBROKESHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL of County Hall, Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire, SA61 1TP (hereinafter referred to as "Pembrokeshire County Council").

Notice is hereby given in accordance with sections 41 and 43 of the School Standards and Organisation (Wales) Act 2013 and the School Organisation Code (July 2013) that Pembrokeshire County Council, having consulted such persons as required, proposes to implement:

1. As from 31st August 2018, discontinue the following schools currently maintained by Pembrokeshire County Council:
 - Sir Thomas Picton School, Queensway, Haverfordwest, SA61 2NX.
 - Tasker Milward VC School, Portfield Avenue, Haverfordwest, SA61 1EQ.

Neither school has a religious character.

2. As from 1st September 2018, establish a new 11-19 voluntary controlled school (hereinafter referred to as the "New Haverfordwest Secondary School") for boys and girls on the sites of the above-named schools. The school will be maintained by Pembrokeshire County Council and the language category will be English Medium (EM); the school will not have a religious character.

As proposer, Pembrokeshire County Council undertook a period of consultation before deciding to publish this proposal. A Consultation Report containing a summary of the issues raised by consultees, the proposer's responses and the views of Estyn, as considered by the County Council, is available on Council's website (www.pembrokeshire.gov.uk).

The Admission Authority will be Pembrokeshire County Council. It is not intended that admission arrangements to the new school will make any provision for selection of pupils by aptitude or by ability (pupil banding). The admission number for each relevant age group for the new school in the first school year in which the proposals will be implemented will be 315. The new school's pupil capacity will be 1863.

Subject to the exercise of any parental preference it is proposed that:

- i. Pupils attending Sir Thomas Picton School and Tasker Milward VC School as at the date of implementation will attend the New Haverfordwest Secondary School.
- ii. Pupils other than those residing in the catchment areas of Johnston CP School and Neyland CP School who but for this proposal would have expected to attend Sir Thomas Picton School or Tasker Milward VC School, will attend the New Haverfordwest Secondary School.
